





Womens Festival Critique Meeting - 20 Aug. 81, 6:00 Present: Sue. M., Maggie, Allison, Carol, Nancy, Kitty, Mareen, Marcia, Lyndsay, Bet, Mary M.. Financial Report passed around for review and discussion. We really put out far too much money for food. A concentrated effort to organize food donations should be made and considerably less bought by the centre. Clean-up commitee should be arranged to save us dollars and not leave other women to do an eight hour clean-up for \$25.00. Commence planning for festival much earlier , like April, than this year, Giving a person one day to draw posters is insufficent. Poster should be Gestetnered rather than putting out \$91.00 for poster printing. Mail out was excessive due to mail strike. Women musicians have agreed to come for next year and we can advertise in advance. There are ten cases of beer we can't locate and thats a lot of loss. Muscians should donate their tome and energy and not be given free booze and food. All others donated their time and energy. Locate local women who might have wanted to donate time to entertain us. Possibly we could make bookings for the band that would allow them to perform for us for free. It was suggested by Marcia to bring down door cost so that more money could go for food. Possibly a Spring Behefit (money raising mixed dance) possibly at the legion. And later the Summer Womens Featival. Compliments on the Film Trip, it was really well done. Discussion re: Winter Solstice, Spring Benefit, with men allowed, Food and booze to make money. Images having a benefit in Oct., so we should hold off till spring. The \$300.00 from BCFW should be returned to Marcia and a regional meeting should happen. Marcia did not take on the job to be an organizer.
