- 1) N.A.C. has funds to provide for travel (return air fare) for ONE delegate from each province or territory. We ask that you contact other Status of Women groups in your province/territory to decide on a representative. (Funding could be divided among several reps if desired.)

It is important that the N.A.C. Office be informed of the chosen representative(s) name, address and phone number before APRIL 30.

- 2) We have been advised by the Secretary of State that funding applications for travel to the NAC Annual Meeting may be made through the provincial/territorial governments. For further information contact the liaison person for IWY with your provincial/territorial government. (Your regional office of the Dept. of Secretary of State, Citizenship Branch, Women's Programmes may also be able to give advice.)
- 3) All N.A.C. Participating Organizations are requested to have ONE delegate with ONE alternate (if possible) attending the meeting. (See Rules of Association.) N.A.C. is unable to fund delegates other than the one representative (as above) and some members of the Board of Management.

In order to get good representation, we are asking all National Organizations to appoint delegates from their regional offices nearer to or in Winnipeg.

ALL INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF N.A.C. AND ITS PARTICIPATING ORGANIZATIONS ARE WELCOME TO ATTEND THE ANNUAL MEETING.
